1. In the present petition, the grievance of the petitioner is that the salary has already been fixed vide order dated 20.11.2020/24.11.2020, copy of which has been appended as Annexure P-4.
2. From the pleadings it transpires that the said grievance has been raised by the petitioner in the legal notice dated 11.09.2023 copy of which has been appended as Annexure P-9 and interest of justice will be served in case the respondents are directed to decide the said legal notice in a time bound manner.
3. Notice of motion.
4. Mr. Shruti, AAG Punjab, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

5. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case the legal notice dated 11.09.2023 (Annexure P-9) has been received in the office of the concerned authorities and the same is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned, the same will be decided by the competent authority within a period of eight weeks from the date of the receipt of certified copy of this order by passing an appropriate speaking order and in case, after the decision any relief is to be extended to the petitioner, the same will be extended, otherwise due reasons will be mentioned in the speaking order to be passed for not accepting the claim of the petitioner for his information and necessary action.

6. Keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, no further orders are required to be passed at this stage and the present petition is disposed of.
