Present civil writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of direction in the nature of mandamus, directing respondents No.1 to 6 to remove the illegal encroachment done by respondents No.7 to 9 measuring about 40 feet on public street near Jalaur Di Chakki at Barnala by constructing wall, installation of gate and uprooting the interlock tiles. Further directing respondents No.2 to 5 to take appropriate legal action against respondents No.7 to 9 for the illegal act done by them in encroaching public street.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that for the redressal of his grievance, petitioner has filed a representation dated 05.04.2021 (Annexure P-4) before the Executive Officer, Municipal

Council, Barnala but the same has not been taken into consideration till date. He has further submitted that the petitioner would be satisfied if his representation dated 05.04.2021 (Annexure P-4) is decided in a time bound manner.

Heard.

After hearing counsel for the parties, respondent No.4- the Executive Officer, Municipal Council, Barnala is directed to decide the representation dated 05.04.2021 (Annexure P-4) filed by the petitioner expeditiously preferably within four weeks from today, in accordance with law.

In view of the above, present petition is disposed of.
