The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 of B.N.S.S with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to him in case FIR No.70 dated 15.05.2024, under Sections 406,420 of IPC and under Section 13 of Punjab Travel Professionals (Regulation) Act, registered at Police Station Mukerian, District Hoshiarpur(Annexure P-1).
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 04.10.2024 passed by this Court, the petitioner has already deposited as an amount of Rs.4,00,000/- with the Court of Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Mukerain and the petitioner has joined the investigation.
3. Learned State counsel also submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for further investigation.
4. In view of the above statement made by learned counsel for the parties, the interim order dated 04.10.2024 is made absolute. The petitioner

shall continue to join the investigation, as and when called by the Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 482 (2) of B.N.S.S.
