1. Present civil revision petition has been filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India for setting aside the impugned order dated 12.08.2024 (Annexure P-8) passed by the Additional Civil Judge, Phillaur, whereby an application under Order VI Rule 17 filed by respondent No.1/plaintiff seeking amendment of plaint (Annexure P-4) has been allowed.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has made a limited prayer to the effect that the petitioner be granted reasonable time to file the amended written statement to the amended plaint filed by respondent No.1. It is submitted that by the impugned order dated 12.08.2024 (Annexure P-8) respondent No.1 has been permitted to file the amended

plaint and the amendment application filed under Order 6 Rule 17 CPC has been allowed. It is further submitted that the last date which had been granted to the petitioner to file the amended written statement is today i.e. 04.10.2024 and since the petitioner is pursuing the present revision petition, thus, a prayer has been made that the petitioner be granted three weeks time to file the amended written statement.

3. In view of the above-said facts and circumstances and also the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the impugned order dated 12.08.2024 (Annexure P-8) is upheld and the petitioner is granted time upto 25.10.2024 to file the amended written statement.

4. Present revision petition is disposed of with the said observation.
