1. The petitioner has filed the present revision petition against the impugned order dated 18.09.2023, passed by the Court of Special Judge, Sangrur, whereby the application filed by the petitioner for staying his conviction was ordered to be dismissed.
2. After arguing at some length, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition, at this stage.
3. Dismissed as withdrawn, at this stage.
4. From the record, it is apparent that the present petitioner was apprehended by the police officials, while he was carrying 3.5 grams of heroin, without any permit or license. He was convicted and sentenced by the Court of Judicial Magistrate First Class, Malerkotla on 24.05.2023. Thereafter, the appeal filed by the petitioner is pending before the Court of Learned Judge, Special Court, Sangrur.

5. At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner contends that appropriate directions may be issued to Special Court to decide the appeal in a time bound manner.

6. The prayer is accepted and keeping in view the peculiar facts and circumstances of the case, the Special Court, Sangrur is directed to decide the appeal filed by the present petitioner within a period of 04 months from receipt of the certified copy of this order.
