JASJIT SINGH BEDI, J.

The petitioner seeks the grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case bearing FIR No.0071 dated 03.08.2022 under Sections 380, 328 and 34 IPC registered at Police Station Sanaur, District Patiala.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 16.10.2023 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

The reply dated 06.01.2024 filed on behalf of the respondent-State is taken on record.

The learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Baljinder Singh submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation in terms of the order dated 16.10.2023 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

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In view of the above, the interim order dated 16.10.2023 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of.
