The instant writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ in the nature of Mandamus to direct respondent Nos.2 and 3 to transfer the remaining land, which has been allotted to the predecessor of the petitioner vide *sanad* dated 24.03.1955 under Section 12 of Displaced persons (Compensation and Rehabilitation Act, 1954).
