VIKAS BAHL, J.(ORAL)

1. This is a Civil Revision Petition filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India for setting aside the order dated 26.06.2024 (Annexure P-6) vide which the application dated 24.06.2024 filed by defendant no.4-petitioner under Order 7 Rule 11 CPC for rejection of plaint has been dismissed.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that since in the impugned order, it has been stated that in case the Court comes to the conclusion at the final stage that the return of the double amount will serve the interest of justice, then the plaintiff would be bound to affix the ad valorem court fee as per the directions of the Court and had also recorded the undertaking of the plaintiff to the said effect, the petitioner seeks to withdraw the present petition with liberty to raise all pleas including the



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plea of court fee, during the course of trial.

3. In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the aforesaid liberty.
