1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondent No.1 to declare him successful candidate for the post of Sub Inspector in the District or Armed Police Cadre .

2. The petitioner pursuant to an advertisement has applied for the post of Sub Inspector in the District as well Armed Police Cadre. He cleared computer based written test. He further successfully cleared long jump test. However, he was again called to clear long jump test wherein he flunked. The petitioner has filed an appeal against action of the respondents which is still pending.
