1. Learned counsel for the respondent relies upon a communication dated 05.11.2024 from the office of District Registrar, Firms and Societies, Panchkula to the State Registrar of Societies, Haryana, as per which, though an observation has been made about the membership issue, yet, no specific order has been passed. Further, the issue of validity of election has been referred to the District Registrar in terms of Section 40(i) of the Haryana Registration and Regulation of Societies Act, 2012.

Learned counsel for the respondent, on instructions, from the concerned authorities submits that the reference forwarded to the office of State Registrar of Societies, Haryana, shall be concluded within a period of one month from today, whereas, the District Registrar Firms and Societies,

Panchkula, shall pass an order on the issue of membership within a period of

two weeks from today and a copy thereof shall be forwarded to the petitioner.

2. In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner does not want to press the present petition. Rule stands discharged.

3. However, in case the needful is not done within the afore-stated period, as per undertaking, the petitioner would be at liberty to seek revival of the present contempt petition and in that eventuality, the erring /concerned officer(s) would be liable to pay additional sum of Rs.50,000/- as costs from his/her own pocket in favour of the petitioner towards litigation expenses, immediately, i.e. on the first date of listing of revival application.
