The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 of B.N.S.S with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to him in case FIR No.367 dated 02.11.2020, under Sections 136 of Central Goods And Services Tax Act, (CGST),2017 and Sections 406,409, 419,420,465,467,468,471,420 and 120-B of IPC, registered at Police Station Civil Lines, District Sirsa (Annexure P-1).
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 03.10.2024 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.
3. Learned State counsel also submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for further investigation.
4. In view of the above statement made by learned State counsel, the interim order dated 03.10.2024 is made absolute. The petitioner shall continue
