JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J (ORAL)

1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondents to count the service rendered as Special Police Officer as qualifying service for the purpose of pensionary/retiral benefits.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner, *inter alia*, contends that case of the petitioner is squarely covered by the judgment of this Court in ***Sukhjit Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and others*** in ***CWP No.9936 of 2017***.

3. Mr. Aman Dhir, DAG, Punjab who on advance notice is present in Court submits that in terms of above stated judgment of this Court, the respondent authorities in the case of various officials have considered their claim and passed orders. He further asserts that appropriate authority would consider case of the petitioner in terms of judgment of this Court in ***Sukhjit Singh (supra)*** and pass an appropriate order within 3 months from today.

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4. In the wake of statement of both sides, the present petition stands disposed of.
