The petitioner has prayed for the following substantive relief:-

“Civil Writ Petition under article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, praying for the issuance of an appropriate writ, order or direction, especially a writ in the nature of Mandamus to direct the Respondents to refund the balance amount i.e. Rs. 23,180/- along with interest @24% per annum from the date of payment till realization

AND

Further prayer is for payment of interest @24% p.a. on Rs. 5,45,300/- which stands refunded to the Petitioner on 04.08.2020 (Anx.P-9) from the date of payment till realization i.e. 04.08.2020.”

After we had heard the matter at some length, when during the course of hearing, learned counsel for the parties have reached a consensus: it would be expedient if the petition is disposed of, at this stage, to enable the competent authority to deal with the

concerns/grievances of the petitioner, as sought to be raised in the petition. And pass necessary orders, in accordance with law, within a period of four weeks from today. It is also agreed that before any such orders are passed, the petitioner shall be afforded a hearing.

In the wake of the position sketched out above and the consensus that has been arrived at between the learned counsel for the parties, the petition is disposed of.

Needless to assert that this order shall not constitute an expression of opinion on the merits of the case of either party, for, as indicated earlier, the competent authority shall examine the grievances of the petitioner, strictly in accordance with law.
