1. Instant petition has been filed by the petitioner seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus so as to seek release of his wife namely Sheetal Devi, who was allegedly detained by her father respondent no.4-Satish and other private respondents.
2. Pursuant to order dated 30.09.2024, a Warrant Officer was appointed, who raided the premises of respondent no.4 and has submitted his report, which reads as under:-

"I was nominated as warrant officer in the instant matter on 30.9.2024. Mr. Naveen friend/known of the petitioner met undersigned the same evening and we left for Police Station, Asandh, as desired by him.

We reached Police Station Asandh at about 10.10 p.m. and on entering I.O. room we met ASI Pawan Kumar, who was officer on duty. After giving introduction and purpose of visit, he was requested to provide police assistance so that orders of Hon'ble Court could be complied with. He arranged



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the police assistance and then waited for lady police assistance which took considerable time as the same was on some event duty, as the same reached.

Thereafter, undersigned along with S.I. Sukhbir belt no.455 karnal along with ASI Pawan kumar other officials and lady constable Seema moved for the Village Chonchra, as desired by the petitioner who also in the meantime reached police station and said that the house of respondent no.4 in the instant petition i.e. father of the alleged detainee be searched, but was unwilling to go to there, for the reasons best known to him. Then, we left for the village Chonchra it took about half an hour to reach there, on reaching there the house of the petitioner was located, and on entering house we met father-Ramnath of respondent no.4, police officials asked him to call his son Satish, Satish came downstairs and after giving introduction he was asked to call the alleged detainee namely sheetal devi. As it took some time for her to come down stairs undersigned along with lady constable namely Seema moved upstairs on entering a room on the right side we met a lady who on asking told that she is alleged detainee -sheetal devi, on asking by the undersigned she said she does not want to live at his father's house and want to live with her husband namely Saurabh, petitioner in the instant case.

Then, alleged detainee-sheetal, undersigned, police officers/officials left the house of Satish and moved for police station.

At the police station, Assandh, Entry with regard to the search at house of Satish was got made, which is annexed with this report, alongwith the statement of the alleged detainee-Sheetal written by her in hindi and statement by the petitioner on the same itself stating that he along with his wife is leaving the Police Station Assandh.



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Thereafter, undersigned left the police station Asandh and moved for Chandigarh and reached in the morning at 4.00 A.M.

3. In view of the aforesaid report, no further directions are required to be issued in the present petition and the same is, accordingly, disposed of.
