1. The present petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for short 'Cr.P.C.') seeking quashing of complaint/application bearing No.COMA/18/2023 under Section 12 of the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005 (for short 'the Act') titled as '*Navnot Kaur Vs. Jagtar Singh*', pending before the Court of learned learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Jalandhar and all the



subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.

2. In view of the settled law pronounced by the Hon’ble Supreme Court in *Kunappareddy Vs. Kunappareddy Swarna Kumari, (2016) 11 SCC 774*, Full Bench of Madras High Court in *Arul Daniel and others Vs. Suganya, 2022 SCC Online Mad 5435* and by the Co-ordinate Bench of this Court in *Jaspal Kaur alias Pinki and others Vs. State of Punjab and others* in *CRM-M-19553-2023* decided on 24.04.2023, the provisions of Cr.P.C. cannot be invoked to challenge proceedings emerging out of the Act.

3. Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioners wishes to withdraw the present petition and seeks liberty to invoke the alternative appropriate remedy on the same cause of action, in accordance with law, for redressal of grievances raised in the present petition.

4. Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.
