This is the second petition filed by the petitioner seeking the relief of regular bail in the criminal case arisen out of the FIR bearing No. 18 dated 13.03.2023 registered at Police Station Sector-3, Chandigarh, under Sections 379-A and 354 read with Section 34 IPC, wherein the offence under Section 323 IPC is stated to have been added later on.

Upon notice, the learned Public Prosecutor has put in appearance and contended that the petitioner has already been acquitted by the Court of the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Chandigarh vide judgment dated 02.12.2023.
