1. Prayer in this appeal is for setting aside order dated 24.05.2024 vide which CWP-11265-2021 filed by petitioner alongwith a number of connected writ petitions were dismissed as premature.

Learned counsel for appellant submits that matter at hand is covered in favour of appellant by decision dated 13.09.2024 passed in LPA-2026-2024 whereby impugned order dated 05.03.2024 in respect to CWP-3164-2024 has been set aside and the matter remanded before learned Single Judge to be heard alongwith CWP-27725 -2013.
