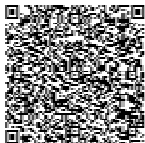

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SHEEL NAGU, C.J. (ORAL)

1. This petition has been filed by the petitioners being aggrieved by the pollution caused by industrial unit of respondent No. 3 producing briquettes from faeces of poultry under the garb of biomass briquettes from agriculture waste.
2. The petitioners are aggrieved by the pollution caused by the aforesaid industry of respondent No. 3 since they are carrying out their respective businesses in close vicinity.
3. After having heard learned counsel for the petitioners and going through the pleadings of the petition, it appears that the cause raised herein, essentially, relates to the grant of consent to operate the factory of respondent No. 3 by the Haryana State Pollution Control Board – respondent No. 2 against which the remedy under the Air



(Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 is before the State Government and thereafter the National Green Tribunal.

4. The petitioners are free to avail the remedy. In case, an appeal is filed within a period of 30 days alongwith copy of this order, the same shall be decided by the concerned authority without being dismissed on limitation alone.

5. The petition, accordingly, stands disposed of.
