5. Learned State counsel, on instructions from Inspector Charan Singh, intimates the Court that the petitioner has joined investigation and is neither required for further investigation nor for any custodial interrogation.

6. During the course of hearing on 04.10.2024, following order was passed:

“ 2. *Learned counsel for the petitioner, inter alia, contends that the petitioner is innocent and has been falsely implicated in this case. He further contends that even as per the FIR, the petitioner is alleged to be empty handed and no specific overt act is attributed to him except for scuffling with the brother of the complainant and as per the allegations in the FIR, it was an unknown person coming out of the car, having mulla fashion beard, who was having pistol in his hand and fired gun shot in the air, and who is not the petitioner at all. He submits that the petitioner is not having any criminal antecedents and is ready to join the investigation.*

3. *Notice of motion.*

4. *On the asking of the Court, Mr. Adesh Pal Singh, AAG, Punjab, present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the State-respondent and prays for time to file the status report/reply in the matter.*

5. *Adjourned to 08.11.2024.*

6. *Needful be done well before the date fixed with an advance copy to the counsel opposite.*

7. *In the meanwhile, the petitioner is hereby directed to join investigation within seven days from today and in the event of his arrest, he is ordered to be released on interim bail on his furnishing personal/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer. He*

shall also abide by conditions as envisaged under Section 482 (2) of BNSS, 2023.”

7. Keeping in view the above submissions made by learned State counsel and the fact that the petitioner had joined the investigation consequent to the order dated 04.10.2024 passed by this Court, interim bail granted vide order dated 04.10.2024 is hereby confirmed, subject to conditions as envisaged under Section 482 (2) of BNSS, 2023. Further the petitioner is directed to join investigation as and when required in future by way of written notice for such purpose to be served by Investigating Officer of this case upon the petitioner; he will not tamper with the evidence nor will influence the witnesses and will not leave the country without prior permission of the Court.

8. The petition stands allowed.

9. It is made clear that anything contained hereinabove shall not be construed to be an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
