By way of present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C.,
petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR no.395 dated
30.08.2022 registered under Sections 420, 467, 468 and 471 of IPC at Police
Station Panchkula, Sector-5, Panchkula (Haryana).

On 31.01.2024, following order was passed:

*“Status report by way of an affidavit dated 22.01.2024 of
Shri Surender Singh, HPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police,
Panchkula has already been filed on behalf of respondent- State,
received through registry. Copy supplied.*

Adjourned to 13.03.2024.

*In the meantime, in case of arrest, the petitioner shall be
released on interim bail subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting
Officer/Investigating Officer. However, it is directed that the
petitioner shall join the investigation as and when so required by the*

Investigating Officer. He shall not contact any person associated with the case to dissuade him from the investigation in any manner whatsoever and nor shall leave the country without prior permission of the Court. He shall further comply with the conditions stipulated in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. ”

Today learned State counsel, on instructions submits that petitioner has since joined the investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

Having regard to the aforesaid facts and circumstances, but without commenting anything further on the merits of the case order dated 31.01.2024 is hereby made absolute, whereby petitioner was granted interim anticipatory bail.

However, the petitioner shall continue to join the investigation as and when called upon to do so by the Investigating Agency and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
