KULDEEP TIWARI, J.(Oral)

1. Through the instant petition, prayer is made for issuing a *mandamus* upon the official respondents no.2 to 4 to protect the life, liberty and property of the present petitioners, at the hands of respondents no.5 to 11.

2. A perusal of the instant petition reflects that, in fact the instant petition is a misconceived motion, inasmuch as, despite the petitioners being seized of an alternate and efficacious statutory remedy for redressal of their grievance, yet they have sidetracked the said remedy and have straightway accessed this Court, through instituting the present petition.

3. Faced with the above difficulty, learned counsel for the petitioners seeks permission of this Court to withdraw the instant petition, however, with liberty reserved to the petitioners to recourse with an alternative available statutory remedy(ies) before the appropriate court/authority/forum concerned, for redressal of their grievance.
4. **Dismissed as withdrawn** with the aforesaid liberty.
