In the present petition, the grievance of the petitioner is that petitioner has applied for the re-issue of the passport in April, 2023 vide File No. JA2077800208623 (Annexure P-3) but even after one and half year, the said application has not attained finality, which is causing prejudice as, the wife of the petitioner is suffering from an ailment and her daughter is residing in America, where the petitioner intends to take his wife for further medical treatment.
