Learned State counsel has filed a short reply dated 29.01.2024 by way of an affidavit of Avtar Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Abohar (Rural), District Fazilka on behalf of respondent Nos.4 and 5-State, which is taken on record. Fazilka to submit a cancellation report in the present case before the concerned jurisdictional Court at Fazilka.
