Application is allowed as prayed for. Documents (Annexures P-4 to P-8) are taken on record.

Main case

1. By way of present petition, prayer has been made for initiation of contempt proceedings against the respondents on account of alleged willful non-compliance of order dated 01.05.2024 passed by this Court in CWP-9886-2024.

2. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that due to on going procurement issue, compliance of aforementioned order dated 01.05.2024 could not be done, however, the same shall be complied with by the

respondents by passing a speaking order within a period of two weeks from today.

3. In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed in the present petition, as such, the same is disposed of. Rule stands discharged.

4. However, in case the needful is not done within the aforementioned period, as per the undertaking, the petitioner would be at liberty to seek revival of contempt petition and in that eventuality, the erring/concerned officer would be liable to pay a sum of Rs.50,000/- as costs from his/her own pocket in favour of the petitioner towards litigation expenses, immediately, i.e. on the first date of listing of revival application.
