HARKESH MANUJA, J. (ORAL)

Learned counsel for the respondent refers to recommendation letter dated 18.11.2024 issued by the office of respondent in the name of petitioner No. 1 (Aneeta Sharma), whereby she has been recommended for the post of Art and Craft Teacher. He further, on telephonic instructions from Ms. Kamal Preet Kaur, Additional Director (Admn.), submits that the appointment / joining to petitioner No. 1 in terms of letter dated 18.11.2024 shall be granted within a period of three weeks from today.

[2] As regards the claim of petitioner No. 2 (Dinesh Kumar), learned counsel for the respondent has produced a copy of speaking order dated 18.11.2024, whereby his claim has been rejected due to securing lesser marks.

[3] In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition any further, however, seeks liberty to challenge

the speaking order dated 18.11.2024 passed by the respondent in respect of petitioner No. 2.

[4] Dismissed as not pressed.

[5]However, in case the needful is not done within the afore-stated period, as per undertaking, petitioner No. 1 would be at liberty to seek revival of the present contempt petition and in that eventuality, the erring / concerned officer(s) would be liable to pay additional sum of Rs.50,000/- as costs from his/her own pocket in favour of petitioner No. 1 towards litigation expenses, immediately, i.e. on the first date of listing of revival application.

[6]Petitioner No. 2 is given liberty to challenge the speaking order dated 18.11.2024 passed by the respondent, as per law.

[7]Rule stands discharged.

[8]Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed off.
