Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. with a prayer to issue appropriate directions to respondent Nos.1 to 3 to ensure that the petitioners are not subjected unnecessary harassment and humiliation by repeatedly summoning and detaining them with a view to arm twist them for extraneous considerations at the instance of respondent No.5.

2. Status report dated 08.03.2024 by way of an affidavit of Nirdosh Kaur, PPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police, CAW & C-Cell, Ludhiana, on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3 has been filed on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3 and the same is taken on record. Status report dated 17.11.2023 filed on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 4 is also taken on record.

3. Learned State counsel, at the outset, by relying upon the status report, submits that the veracity of the allegations made by the petitioner in Annexure P-3 has been thoroughly examined and it was recommended that no further action is required to be taken on the complaint made by petitioner No.1

and same was ordered to be consigned to record room. Similarly, the complaint filed by respondent No.5 has also been thoroughly examined and it was recommended that no further action is required to be taken and the complaint made by respondent No.5 was ordered to be consigned to record room. The proceedings under Section 125 Cr.P.C. are pending before the Family Court at Ludhiana between the parties.

4. In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioners wishes to withdraw the present petition with liberty to invoke his alternative remedy as available to him in accordance with law.
