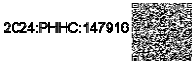

This petition has been filed, *inter alia*, seeking a writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to grant the benefit of additional ten per cent basic pay plus Dearness Allowance (D.A.) per month, as per notification dated 13.04.2022, Annexure P-2, and Teacher Transfer Policy 2023, dated 09.08.2023, Annexure P-3, since the petitioners have been posted in district Nuh (Mewat).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that grievance raised herein is pending for appropriate decision before the respondents. At this stage, the petitioners will be satisfied in case the second respondent is directed to decide the pending legal notice, dated 26.07.2024, Annexure P-4, in a specified period.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Ms. Tanushree Gupta, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents/State and submits that the pending legal notice, dated 26.07.2024, will be decided by the second respondent-Director,



Elementary Education, Haryana, by passing a speaking/reasoned order in accordance with law within a period of three months.

5. In view of the statement made, learned counsel for the petitioners has no objection to the petition being disposed of in terms thereof.
6. Ordered accordingly.
7. In case the order is not passed within the stipulated period, the officer concerned shall pay costs of ₹50,000 to the petitioners.
