1. While issuing notice of motion on 18.10.2023, following order was passed:-

“Prayer is for quashing of order dated 7th of October, 2023 (Annexure P-1) passed by the Ld. Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Samalkha, District Panipat whereby the bail of the petitioner stands cancelled on account of his absence in case FIR No.17 dated 10th of January, 2021 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B and 201 of IPC, at Police Station Samalkha, District Panipat.

Issue notice of motion returnable for 29.01.2024.

Mr. Gaurav Bansal, DAG, Haryana appears and accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

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In the meantime, operation of the impugned order dated 7th of October, 2023 (Annexure P-1) shall remain stayed subject to the petitioner appearing before the Trial Court today.

Copy of this order be given to counsel for the petitioner under the signatures of the Bench Secretary of this Court.”

2. Today, Ms. Sonia has produced order dated 18.10.2023 passed by the trial Court to submit that the petitioner appeared before the trial Court in compliance of the order passed by this Court. She further submits that the petitioner undertakes to appear before the trial Court regularly without any fault.
3. In view of above, this Court does not find any need to pass further orders.
4. Resultantly, the present petition is disposed off. Order dated 18.10.2023 is made absolute, subject to the condition that the petitioner shall continue to appear before the trial Court.
