1. Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.101 dated 06.07.2024 for the offence under Section 22, 25 (Sections 29, 61, 85 added lateron) of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Sadar Jagraon, District Ludhiana Rural.
2. Vide order dated 04.10.2024, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 04.10.2024, petitioner has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute.
4. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Surjit Singh, has affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for further investigation.
5. In view of the above, interim order dated 04.10.2024 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) BNSS.
6. Petition stands allowed.
