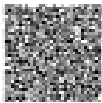

SHEEL NAGU, C.J. (Oral)

1. The petitioner has raised certain charges of corruption against respondent No.4-Sub Registrar, Ludhiana, and has prayed for registration of FIR.
2. The remedy under Section 156(3) or Section 200 of the Cr.P.C. (Section 173/175/223 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (BNSS) is always available to the petitioner.
3. Further, remedy of approaching the Lokayukta, Punjab is also available to the petitioner, which can very well be availed.
4. Accordingly, this Court disposes of the present petition without entering into merits of the case, with liberty to the petitioner to avail appropriate remedy.
