1. The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.84 dated 10.08.2024, under Sections 498-A, 323, 406 IPC, (Sections 85, 86, 115(2) and 316(2) of BNS, added later on), registered at Police Station Dhariwal, District Gurdaspur.
2. The petitioner was directed to join the investigation, as per the order dated 03.10.2024.
3. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent-State confirms that the petitioner has joined investigation and also contends that his further custodial interrogation is not required.

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4. As per the report of the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court, the matter stands settled between the parties.

5. In view of the reasons recorded in the order dated 03.10.2024 and keeping in view the fact that the petitioner has joined investigation, his further custodial interrogation is not required by the Investigating Agency, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 03.10.2024 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

6. However, it is made clear that nothing expressed hereinabove would be construed to be an expression of opinion on merits of the case.
