1. Challenge in the present petition is to the order dated 20.09.2024 (Annexure P-1) issued by respondent No.5, whereby services of the petitioner as Assistant Manager, were terminated w.e.f. 20.09.2024.
2. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that as is apparent from the appointment letter (Annexure P-2), the petitioner was to report on duty at 61 Sub Area Chinkara Canteen (Main), Jaipur, on 01.05.2014, which falls in the South Western Command, Jaipur. As such, this Court has no jurisdiction to interfere in the matter.
3. In view of the objection taken regarding jurisdiction, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the present petition with liberty to avail the remedy before the court of competent jurisdiction.
4. Ordered accordingly.
