1. By way of present petition filed under Section 10 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, prayer has been made for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondent for alleged non-compliance of the Order dated 10.05.2023 passed by this Court in CWP-10115-2023.

2. Learned counsel for the respondent informs that the dues payable to the petitioner have been cleared except qua the two bills regarding which payment shall be released within a period of one week from today.

3. In view of the aforesaid undertaking, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition at this stage.

4. Dismissed as not pressed.

5. However, in case the needful is not done within the aforementioned period, as per the undertaking, the petitioner would be at liberty to seek revival of the contempt petition and in that eventuality, the erring/concerned Officer would be liable to pay additional sum of Rs.50,000/- as costs from his/her own pocket in favour of the petitioner

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towards litigation expenses, immediately, i.e. on the first date of listing of revival application.

6. Rule stands discharged.
