The present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, *inter alia*, seeking a writ in the nature of Mandamus for directing the respondents to enter/sanction the mutation in favour of the petitioner, being legal heir of Balak Ram Jain, on the basis of inheritance in respect of land having area 450 square yards falling in Khasra No.3867/2 (min), Hadbast No.12 area 450 square yards situated within the revenue estate of Village Patti Insar, Panipat, Teshil and District Panipat.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner, after arguing for some time, submits that he may be permitted to withdraw the instant writ petition with

liberty to the petitioner to avail his remedies in terms of Section 45 of the Land Revenue Act, 1887.

3. Keeping in view the aforesaid submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid.
4. All the pending application(s), if any, shall also stand closed.
