1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 528 of B.N.S.S with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to him in case FIR No.30, dated 31.03.2023, under Sections 307,324,341,323,506,148 and 149 of IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Rajpura, District Patiala (Annexure P-1).
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 03.10.2024 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.
3. Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Sukhwant Singh also submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation on 05.11.2024 and is no longer required for further investigation.
4. In view of the above statement made by learned counsel for the parties, the interim order dated 03.10.2024 is made absolute. The petitioner shall continue to join the investigation, as and when called by the Investigating

Officer. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as specified under
Section 482 (2) of B.N.S.S/438(2) of Cr.P.C.
