Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that there are certain posts which are lying vacant near Gurdaspur and Amritsar where the petitioner can be adjusted keeping in view the fact that the son of the petitioner is suffering from Thalaseemia and is under constant supervision of the Amritsar Medical College for the said disease hence, the present writ petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to the petitioner to file appropriate representation with the respondents for adjusting him near Gurdaspur or Amritsar wherever the same is feasible for the respondents.

3. Mr. Satnam Preet Singh, learned Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

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4. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case any representation is received at the hands of the petitioner, the same will be decided by the competent authority within a period of two weeks from the receipt of any such representation/claim by passing an appropriate speaking order and in case, after the decision any relief is to be extended to the petitioner, the same will be extended, otherwise due reasons will be mentioned in the speaking order to be passed for not accepting the claim of the petitioner for his information and necessary action.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present writ petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to the petitioner to file appropriate representation with the respondents.
