Prayer in the present petition is for directing the respondents to release the due payment of Rs.1,98,99,816/- qua the work of augmentation of water supply pipeline project at Jalandhar Town Package 1C Zone 6 & 7 under AMRUT executed by the petitioner, alongwith interest @ 12% per annum.

After arguing at some length, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that with regard to his grievance, the petitioner has submitted various representations followed by a legal notice dated 30.08.2024 (Annexure P-4) but the respondents have neither paid the outstanding dues to the petitioner nor have they taken any action upon the said legal notice.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Aditya Sharda, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 and 2; and prays for some time to complete instructions and file response, if necessary.



Mr. Saurav Verma, Addl. A.G., Punjab, who by virtue of his assignment is also on the panel of all the statutory corporations and bodies of the Government of Punjab, is directed to accept notice on behalf of respondents No.3 and 4. Hence, he accepts notice on behalf of the said respondents and also prays for some time to complete instructions and file response.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, however, contends that he would be satisfied at this stage, in case respondent No.3- Commissioner, Municipal Corporation, Dr. B.R. Ambedkar Complex, Nehru Garden Road, Jalandhar is directed to consider and decide the legal notice dated 30.08.2024 (Annexure P-4) served by the petitioner, by passing a speaking order in a time bound manner.

Learned counsel for respondents No.3 and 4 has no objection to the request made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

Accordingly, in view of the above; with the consent of the parties and without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of while directing respondent No.3 to consider and decide the legal notice dated 30.08.2024 (Annexure P-4) by passing a reasoned and speaking order after affording an opportunity of hearing to the respective parties within a period of three months of the receipt of certified copy of this order.

Needless to mention that upon considering the said legal notice, if any amount is found due and payable to the petitioner, the same shall be disbursed in favour of the petitioner within a further period of three months.



In the event of non-payment of dues within the abovesaid period, the same shall be released along with interest @ 6% per annum from the date of filing of present petition to be paid to the petitioner and further subject to additional payment of costs of Rs.50,000/- to be deposited with the Poor Patient Welfare Fund (PPWF) of Post Graduate Institute of Medical Education & Research, Chandigarh. The said additional financial liability of accrued interest and costs shall be subject to recovery from the erring official.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
