NAMIT KUMAR, J. (ORAL)

1. Instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of *mandamus* for direction to release the payment of arrears of revised pay/pension w.e.f. 01.01.2016 to 30.06.2021 and to grant benefit of revised pension by taking into consideration DA @ 119% as on 31.12.2015 instead of DA @ 113% w.e.f. 01.01.2016 and subsequent hikes in dearness allowance at par with Central Government pattern as recommended by the Sixth Pay Commission along with interest @ 18% per annum on delayed payments.
2. After arguing the case for some time, learned counsel for the petitioners wishes to withdraw this petition with liberty to first approach the competent authority for redressal of their grievances.
3. Dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty.
