The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing NCB Crime No.18/2023 dated 08.07.2023 registered under Sections 8, 18, 23, 25, 27-A, 29 and 60 of the NDPS Act, 1985.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 31.10.2023, the petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

A reply dated 24.01.2024 has been filed on behalf of the respondent-UoI by the learned counsel for the UoI. The same is taken on record. She on instructions admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 31.10.2023 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
