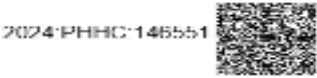

1. Through this writ petition, the petitioner prays for issuance of directions to respondents no.1 and 2 to re-issue the fresh passport pursuant to application reference no.ARN24-0000237888, dated 13.03.2024.

2. Pursuant to supply of an advance copy of the writ petition, Ms. Shreyansi Verma, Advocate, entered appearance on behalf of respondent nos.1 and 2 and submits that the petitioner's application was inadvertently closed and the Regional Passport Officer, Chandigarh (hereinafter referred to as 'the RPO, Chandigarh'), is prepared to revive the same, the moment the petitioner submits fresh application for which no charges shall be payable.

3. Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the writ petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to submit the fresh application for issuance of the passport before the RPO, Chandigarh, which shall be taken up and processed immediately.

4. The learned counsel representing the RPO, Chandigarh, submits



that the entire process at the end of the RPO, Chandigarh, subject to police verification shall be completed within three weeks.

5. All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
