RAJESH BHARDWAJ J.

Present petition has been filed for issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondents No.2 and 3 to remove the illegal encroachment from cemented place of selling vegetables at Krishna Colony Sabji Chowk Bhiwani from illegal encroachers and to allot that cemented place through draw system to the members of the petitioner association.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondent No.3- Municipal Council, Bhiwani, has filed his power of attorney in the Court today and same is taken on record.

It has been submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that there are illegal encroachments made at Krishna Colony Sabji Chowk Bhiwani. He submits that the petitioner had approached the respondent- authority number of times for removing the same, however, no action has

been taken till date and thus, the petitioner has approached this Court by way of filing of the present writ petition.

Learned counsel for respondent No.3 has fairly submits that the petitioner would be given a personal hearing and on hearing the grievances, necessary order would be passed.

Learned State counsel affirms the submissions made by learned counsel for respondent No.3.

In view of the same, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 i.e. Executive Officer, Municipal Committee Bhiwani, to treat the present petition as a representation made by the petitioner/association.

The representative of the petitioner/association is directed to appear before respondent No.3 on 08.05.2024 at 11:00 am, then respondent No.3 would grant them hearing and decide the matter by passing necessary order within four weeks thereafter in accordance with law.
