MAHABIR SINGH SINDHU, J.

Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution, *inter alia*, for directing the respondents to decide the statutory Revision Petition (P-3), filed under Rule 16.32 of the Punjab Police Rules, as applicable to Haryana, against the order dated 10.11.2017, passed by the Appellate Authority in an appeal against punishment order dated 28.08.2017 (P-1), whereby petitioner's services were dismissed merely on the basis of conviction in FIR No.87 dated 27.08.2016, under Section 384 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Sections 7, 13 of the Prevention of Corruption Act, registered at Police Station Sadar, Jagadhri.

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- (2) At the time of hearing, learned State Counsel has produced copy of order dated NIL (bearing No.18557 dated 12.11.2024), which is taken on record as Mark ‘X’. Copy thereof supplied to the opposite side.
- (3) A perusal of the aforesaid order reveals that revision petition of the petitioner has been dismissed.
- (4) In view of the above development, learned Counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file fresh petition with better particulars, including challenge to the aforesaid order in accordance with law.
- (5) Disposed off with liberty aforesaid.
- (6) It is clarified that above observations be not construed as an expression of opinion on merits of the case in any manner.

Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed off.
