By way of present petition filed under Section 482 of BNSS, 2023, petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR (Annexure P-1) as under:

FIR No.	Dated	Sections	Police Station
132	14.08.2024	333, 115 (2), 351 (2), 191 (3), 190, 304 of BNS and Section 238 of BNS added later on.	Lehra, District Sangrur, Punjab.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance to the order dated 23.10.2024 passed by this Court, the petitioner has already joined the investigation and as such prayed for confirming the interim bail granted vide order dated 23.10.2024 .
3. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Rameshwar Dass intimates the Court that the petitioner has joined investigation and is neither required for further investigation nor for any custodial interrogation.



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4. During the course of hearing on 23.10.2024, following order was passed:

“ Reply has not been filed by the State.

Learned State counsel seeks more time to file reply in the matter.

ASI Rameshwar Dass is present in Court along with record.

Admittedly, the injury attributed to the petitioner on the right leg of the injured is simple in nature and all other offences are bailable in nature except for the offence under Section 333 of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023.

List on 18.11.2024.

In the meanwhile, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petitioner is hereby directed to join investigation within seven days from today and co-operate in the same. In the event of the arrest of the petitioner, he shall be released on interim bail on his furnishing personal/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer. He shall also abide by conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) BNSS. ”

5. Keeping in view the above submissions made by learned State counsel and the fact that the petitioner had joined the investigation consequent to the order dated 23.10.2024 passed by this Court, interim bail granted vide order dated 23.10.2024 is hereby confirmed, subject to conditions as envisaged under 482 (2) of BNSS, 2023. Further the petitioner is directed to join investigation as and when required in future by way of written notice for such purpose to be served by Investigating Officer of this case upon the petitioner; he will not tamper with the

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evidence nor will influence the witnesses and will not leave the country without prior permission of the Court.

6. The petition stands allowed.
7. It is made clear that anything contained hereinabove shall not be construed to be an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
