In the present petition, the grievance of the petitioner is that respondent No. 2 has been appointed as Anganwadi worker without considering the claim of the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is more meritorious than respondent No. 2 but she has been ignored so as to appoint respondent No. 2.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Swapan Shorey, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that the present petition has been filed without raising any grievance before the authorities concerned and in case, any such grievance is raised by the petitioner before



the authorities, appropriate order on the said grievance will be passed within a period of eight weeks of the receipt of any such representation on behalf of the petitioner and in case, it is found feasible to accept the claim of the petitioner, the same will be accepted, otherwise due reasons will be mentioned in the speaking order, which will be conveyed to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to file appropriate representation before the authorities concerned.
