1. The instant petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and his family at the hands of respondents No.4 to 6, who are threatening the petitioner of false implication.

2. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to respondent No.2-Commissioner of Police, Amritsar to look into the representation dated 30.07.2024 (Annexure P-4) at the earliest and take appropriate steps as may be required under the law so that his life and liberty may not be jeopardized.

4. Notice of motion.

5. On asking of the Court, Mr. Navdeep Singh, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents.

6. In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of

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with directions to respondent No.2-Commissioner of Police, Amritsar to look into the representation dated 30.07.2024 (Annexure P-4) and take necessary steps at the earliest, if any required, in accordance with law.
