SHEEL NAGU, CHIEF JUSTICE (Oral)

1. This petition has been filed for issuance of a direction to Indian Nursing Council (respondent No.3) to grant affiliation to Maharishi Dayanand Institute of Nursing, Hisar (respondent No.6).



2. During pendency of this petition, vide five separate letters dated 29.11.2023 (Annexure R-3) issued by respondent No.3 – INC, respondent No.6 Institute has been found suitable to conduct ANM, GNM, M.Sc (N), B.Sc (N) and P.B. B.Sc (N) courses with intake capacities of 40 (Forty), 40 (Forty), 25 (Twenty Five), 50 (Fifty) and 20 (Twenty) seats, respectively, all relating to academic year 2023-24.
3. In view of above, learned counsel for the petitioners does not dispute that the cause raised herein has become infructuous.
4. It appears that the grievance raised in this petition stands redressed. However, liberty is extended to the petitioners to re-visit the Court in case any part of the grievance remains unredressed.
5. Petition stands dismissed as infructuous accordingly with aforesaid liberty.
