1. Learned counsel for the respondents relies upon an office order dated 28.10.2024, as per which, the sanction stands accorded for a sum of Rs.11,59,594/- in favour of the petitioner. He further submits that even the said amount stands credited to the account of the petitioner on 09.11.2024.
