1. Prayer in this writ petition is for issuance of a writ especially in the nature of mandamus for directing the respondents to count the period of former service for computing pension of the petitioner and all the consequential benefits including arrears.
2. The order 06.05.2024 has not been complied with and the legal representative(s) of the petitioner have not been brought on record. Notice was sent to the family of the petitioner through registered post about the pendency of the present petition and it has been reported that the same has been duly served. However, there is no representation on behalf of them.
3. In the light of the above, the present writ petition is dismissed at this stage with liberty to the legal representative(s) of the petitioner to move an appropriate application for revival of the present case, in case, any

cause of action survives considering the fact that the suit filed by the petitioner already stands dismissed.
