1. Through the instant petition, prayer is for issuance of a direction upon the respondents to conduct fair and impartial investigating in case FIR No.77, dated 07.03.2021 (Annexure P-1), under Section 420, 465, 468 and 471 of the IPC, registered at Police Station Ranjit Avenue, District Amritsar.

2. Upon notice, a short reply dated 30.01.2024, by way of an affidavit of Mr.Varinder Singh Khosa, ACP, North, District Amritsar, has been filed by the learned State counsel today in Court, which is taken on record.

3. The aforesaid reply gives details of the investigation in the FIR carried out so far by the investigating officer, which reads as under:-

“6. That it is respectfully submitted that during the course of investigation of the aforesaid case/FIR No. 77/2021 (supra), the accused DR. Navrattan Devgan wife of Dr. Parveen Devga resident of E-Block Ranjit Avenue (Owner of Altec Hospital), who was granted relief of interim bail vide order dated 13.9.21 passed in

CRM-M-15813-2021 by this Hon'ble Court, joined the investigation on 06.10.2021.

7. That it is respectfully submitted that on dated 07.10.2021, during investigation accused named as Dr. Parveen Devgan was nominated in this case and Raid was conducted at the house of accused Dr. Parveen Devgan, But he was not found present at his home.

8. That it is respectfully submitted that the present case FIR No. 77/2021 (Supra) qua the accused DR, Navrattan Devgan and Dr. Parveen Devgan is under investigation, which shall be taken to its logical conclusion and Final report shall be submitted before the learned court.”

4. A perusal of the above reveals that the investigation is heading in a right direction.

5. Therefore, considering aforesaid reply filed on behalf of the State, at this stage, no further action is required by this Court. Accordingly, the instant petition is **disposed of**.
