Instant petition under Section 528 of the Bhartiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita 2023 (BNSS) has been preferred seeking directions to respondent No. 2 to get the investigation completed in fair and unbiased manner in case FIR (Annexure P-1) as under: -

2. Heard.
3. It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that in the array of parties respondent No. 3 has been wrongly mentioned as Senior Superintendent of Police, Police Lines, Jind, District Jind, whereas, it is Superintendent of Police, Police Lines, Jind, District Jind. He prays that the same may be ordered to be read as Superintendent of Police instead of Senior Superintendent of Police.

4. Ordered accordingly.
5. Registry is directed to carry out the necessary correction in the array of parties.
6. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner had got the aforesaid FIR registered on 28.06.2024 and on account of investigation being conducted in partial and biased manner, he had moved various representations to the authorities including representation dated 10.07.2024 (Annexure P-3) to the Superintendent of Police, Haryana Police, Jind, but no action on the said representation(s) has been taken till date.
7. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that for the purpose of the present petition, the petitioner will be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to respondent No. 3 to consider and dispose of the representation dated 10.07.2024 (Annexure P-3) in accordance with the law in an expeditious manner.
8. Notice of motion to the official respondents.
9. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Surender Singh, AAG, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the State-respondents No. 1 to 4 and submits that the aforesaid representation will be considered and disposed of expeditiously.
10. In the circumstances of the case and without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No. 3, Superintendent of Police, Police Lines, Jind,

District Jind, to consider the averments made in the representation dated 10.07.2024 (Annexure P-3), to dispose of the same expeditiously and to take action, as warranted, under the provisions of the law.
